About this course (SCQF 5/6)



NC Creative Printmaking with Photography

About this course (SCQF 6)

This one year course will allow you to develop and nurture creative and technical skills in a variety of traditional and commercial printing processes for the printing, photography and design industries and supports the development of critical thinking and evaluation.

- Two Standard Grades at Level 3 or above in English and Art/Graphic Communication or relevant subject (or equivalent)
- Portfolio/examples of work

NC Photography

About this course (SCQF 6)

This one year course offers you the opportunity to learn about the basic creative and technical aspects of a range of photographic specialisms. The course covers the key photographic skills for students who want to learn the fundamentals of photography, working in a photo studio and on location.

- Two Standard Grades at Level 4 or above in English and Art/Graphic Communication or English and IT related subject

HND Photography

About this course (SCQF 7/8)

This two year course provides the skills you need to start a career in photography or a related area within the creative industries. It's practice-based, with projects both in the studio and on location. The course offers candidates an opportunity to work independently on self initiated projects.

BA (Hons) Photography

About this course (SCQF 9)

This one or two year course in photography is a collaboration between City of Glasgow College and the University of the West of Scotland (UWS). The course focuses on practice-led photographic areas and work-related experience while providing opportunities for business, entrepreneurship and enterprise activities.

What you need

- You'll need to have an HND in Photography or relevant professional experience for entry into Year 3
- All candidates will be interviewed and assessed on their portfolio
- You should apply through UCAS using UCAS code W690 M BA/PhDI

HNC Creative Printmaking

About this course (SCQF 7)

This course offers an opportunity to develop your creative talents allowing you to develop traditional and contemporary printmaking skills. Various printmaking techniques and media are explored and supplemented with technical and creative skills in digital media and new technologies.

What you need

- Art & Design Higher and English at minimum Intermediate level 2, OR
- An NC/NQ qualification in print, design or equivalent SVQ
- Portfolio/examples of work

HNC/D Practical Journalism

About this course (SCQF 7/8)

Journalists must have the essential skills of writing and research but are now expected to record sound, shoot video and edit on digital systems. They are increasingly expected to produce web content. This two year course equips you to succeed in this modern media environment.

What you need

- Higher English plus three Standard Grades at Credit level, OR
- NC Media or equivalent, and
- Some practical skills in IT, including word processing, email and internet
- At your interview you will have to produce a 200 word article; correct spelling, grammar and punctuation in a 300 word article; discuss the importance of journalism

NC Television Production HNC/D Creative Industries: Television

About this course (SCQF 7/8)

NC - This one year course covers basic skills in all areas of television production.

HNC - This one year course is a highly practical course covering the main aspects of television production.

HND - This two year course develops skills in all areas of television production, including camera, sound, editing, sound dubbing and lighting.
