Welcome to the School of Hair, Beauty & Sport. The following pages give brief details of our courses. Full details for all courses can be found on our website.

Some of our courses will require you to attend for an interview. All course entry is subject to the outcome of discussion at the interview and satisfactory references. At the interview you should be able to demonstrate an interest in your chosen subject. If you don't have the required qualifications, we'll consider you for a place based on your experience - contact course leaders for further information.

Students studying for a two year HND can choose to leave after one year of study with an HNC.

Once you've finished your course, you have the option to move on to a higher level course:

- **Access - Apply for NC/NQ courses at the college**

- **NC/NQ - Apply for HNC/HND courses at the college**
- **HNC/D - Apply for degree level courses**

Alternatively, you can go into related employment.

Below we've given you some examples of the career options available if you complete one of our Hair, Beauty & Sport courses:

Beauty Therapist in a Salon, Health Spa, or Cruise Ship, Self Employment, Holistic Therapy, Complementary Therapy, Hairdresser, Make-Up or Beauty Business, Barber, Local Authority Sports Attendant, Community/Youth Worker, Sports Development Officers, Sports Co-ordinators, Sports Therapists, Self Employment.

Access to Beauty Therapy

About this course (SCQF 5/6)

Exciting and challenging, this is a full-time, two-year course. You'll study beauty treatments and related subjects. This course is suitable for those with no formal school qualifications, or those looking to get back into education.

What you need

- There are no formal entry requirements, however you will need to demonstrate excellent communication skills
- We advise you to apply early as this is a popular course

Please note:

- If you have 3 Standard Grades at Grade 4 or above you should apply for NCGA Beauty Care and Make-up Level 5
- If you have 4 Standard Grades at Grade 3 or above or equivalent, or higher qualifications then you should apply for NCGA Beauty Care Level 6

NCGA Beauty Care and Make-Up (Level 5)

About this course (SCQF 5)

An excellent introduction to beauty, this one year course provides qualifications you need to gain a junior role within the beauty industry as well as professional membership and insurance. You'll study beauty treatments and related subjects.

What you need

- 3 Standard Grades at Grade 4 or above
- You will need to demonstrate excellent communication skills and an understanding of and enthusiasm for the beauty industry

NCGA Beauty Care (Level 6)

About this course (SCQF 6)

This one year course will allow you to develop practical professional skills required to work effectively in the beauty industry and achieve the entry qualifications necessary for application to the HND Beauty Therapy. The course provides qualifications you need for professional membership and insurance and employment in the beauty industry. You'll study beauty treatments and related subjects.

What you need

- Four Standard Grades at Level 3 or above, English and a Science preferred
- Previous experience or a qualification in Beauty Care is an advantage e.g. NCGA Beauty Care Level 5

HND Beauty Therapy

About this course (SCQF 8)

This two year course covers a wide range of therapies and management skills. You'll gain a comprehensive understanding of facial and body problems, and the application of treatments in a salon environment. You'll develop analytical skills, devise suitable treatment plans and evaluate the effectiveness of the treatments. Up to the minute training in current professional product ranges e.g. Darphin, Dermalogica and Thalgo is included in the course.

What you need

- Two Higher Grade passes at C or above, one of which should be English, OR
- NCGA Level 6 in Beauty Care /SVQ Level 3 Beauty or any other NQ/SVQ at this level

HNC Fashion Make-Up

About this course (SCQF 7)

This one year course includes skin care and eye treatments, plus hairstyling and make-up techniques ranging from basic to fashion and photographic make-up. Taking part in demonstrations will aid your development throughout the course. You will also study customer care and software applications.

What you need

- Experience in the hairdressing industry OR
- NCGA Beauty Care or NC Hairdressing or a National Qualification that combines hairdressing and beauty modules (minimum SCQF Level 5) or an equivalent VQ
- You need to be familiar with computers and have good keyboard skills

SVQ/NQ Gents Hairdressing (Level 2)

About this course (SCQF 5)

This course provides the necessary training if you want a career in Barbering. Assessment includes producing a portfolio of evidence i.e. practical performance assignments, projects and written/oral questions. Work experience is an essential part of this course and you will be required to secure a work placement.

What you need

- You should have experience in or knowledge of the hairdressing/barbering industry or 2 Standard Grades Level 1-4
- You should display qualities, which enable you to communicate with the public
- Applicants must be 16 years of age at start of course

SCQF Ladies Hairdressing (Level 5)

About this course (SCQF 5)

This one year course is designed for those who want a career in hairdressing. Level 5 will enable you to develop and master all of the basic skills that are required for the successful hairdresser. Work experience is an essential part of the course and you will be required to secure a work placement.

What you need

- You should have experience in or knowledge of the hairdressing industry or 2 Standard Grades Level 1-4
- You should display qualities, which enable you to communicate easily with the public
- Applicants must be 16 years of age at start of course

SCQF Ladies Hairdressing (Level 6)

About this course (SCQF 6)

This one year course is designed for those who want a career in hairdressing. Level 6 Ladies Hairdressing will allow you to consolidate your hairdressing skills and develop more elaborate techniques. Work experience is an essential part of the course and you will be required to secure a work placement.

What you need

- If you have successfully completed Ladies Hairdressing Level 5 or have relevant experience in hairdressing you will be considered for an interview.
- You should display qualities, which enable you to communicate easily with the public.
- Applicants must be 16 years of age at start of course

HNC Hairdressing

About this course (SCQF 7)

This one year course is designed for hairdressers seeking an advanced certificate which will develop their creative hairdressing skills, technical knowledge and give them the opportunity to design and create hairstyles. The course also includes building a portfolio which will involve you using computer aided design skills as well as selling skills. You will attend college on a Monday and Tuesday.

What you need

- Basic computing skills
- Successful completion of SVQ 3/SCQF Hairdressing Level 6 or equivalent NQ units or a minimum of 5 years industrial experience
- You should be working in the hairdressing industry

NC Wellness Therapies

About this course (SCQF 6)

This one year course provides qualifications you need for professional membership and insurance or employment in the field of complementary and holistic therapies. You'll study holistic therapies and related subjects to National Certificate level. This can lead to employment or entry to higher level courses.

What you need

There are no formal entry requirements, however you should have:

- An interest in holistic or complementary therapies, and commitment
- An interest in working with people and a high level of personal presentation
- Interpersonal skills
- A Standard Grade (or equivalent) in Biology is desirable, but not essential

HNC/D Complementary Therapies

About this course (SCQF 7/8)

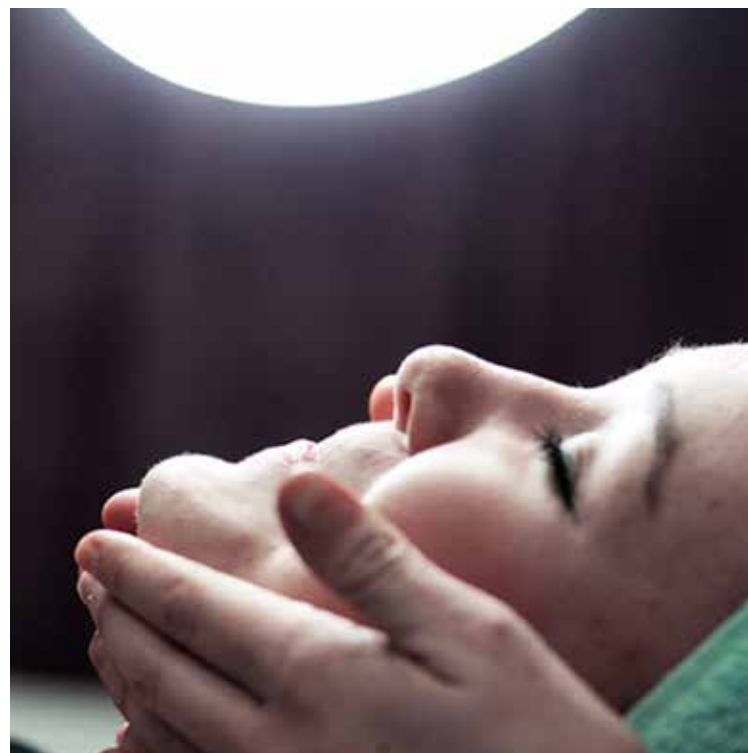
This two year advanced level course aims to produce qualified practitioners. You'll develop many skills on the course, and relate to clients with confidence. You'll participate in a number of extra curricular activities and come to appreciate more deeply the role played by a complementary therapist.

What you need

- Two Higher Grade passes at Grade C or above, including English or equivalent or NQ Communication Intermediate 2 and Higher, or Communication 4
- Two other passes at Standard Grade (or equivalent) at credit level including a science subject, OR
- Appropriate science and vocational modules, OR
- An appropriate NC at Level 6 (eg Beauty Care or Wellness Therapies)

NQ Sport & Leisure

About this course (SCQF 4)

This one year course is an introduction to the skills you'll need for a career in the sport and fitness industry. Mainly practical, it covers sport leadership and fitness, and includes SQA units in a variety of sports activities.

What you need

- There are no formal entry requirements, however you'll need to show a positive attitude towards learning

NC Sport & Fitness

About this course (SCQF 5)

If you want a career in sport, health and fitness or coaching this new one year National Qualification will give you an excellent introduction. The course provides you with knowledge of many aspects of exercise, sports and fitness - including Fitness Training and Exercise Physiology.

What you need

- You should have a range of Intermediate 1 subjects at B or above or 3 Standard Grades at band C or above
- We recommend that you are at least 16 at the start of the course - this will allow you to go on to an HNC

Higher Sport & Leisure

About this course (SCQF 5/6)

This one year course has a number of practical and theory elements that combine to give you a foundation to develop your interest in Sport and Leisure. It will give you an insight into the business of Sport and Leisure providing you with knowledge of many aspects of the industry and what's needed of employees in the sector.

What you need

- 3 Standard Grades at Band 3 or above one of which should be English

NQ Health, Fitness & Sport Performance

About this course (SCQF 6)

This one year course covers a range of SQA units at an advanced level. It's designed to give you options - preparing you for an HNC, but at the same time giving you a sound start for jobs in the sport and leisure industry. Sporting activities are built into the course.

What you need

- 3 National Courses at Intermediate 2 including English or 3 Standard Grades at Band 3 including English, OR
- An appropriate sports qualification at Intermediate 2
- Other equivalent qualifications or experience
- We recommend that you are at least 16 at the start of the course - this will allow you to go on to an HNC

NQ Sports Coaching

About this course (SCQF 6)

This one year course introduces and develops the skills and knowledge you'll need for sports coaching. The principles of good coaching practice are examined and a wide practical and theoretical knowledge of games and sports is developed. You will also have the opportunity to qualify for Sports Coaching awards from National Governing Bodies.

What you need

- 3 National Courses at Intermediate 2 including PE and English, Intermediate 1 Mathematics or Numeracy or 3 Standard Grades at Band 3 including PE, English and Mathematics or Numeracy
- We recommend that you are at least 16 at the start of the course - this will allow you to go on to an HNC

HNC/D Sports Coaching with Development of Sport

About this course (SCQF7/8)

This two year course introduces and develops the skills and knowledge you'll need for sports coaching. The principles of good coaching practice are examined and a wide practical and theoretical knowledge of games and sports is developed. Work experience is included on HNC programmes. You will also have the opportunity to qualify for Sports Coaching awards from National Governing Bodies.

What you need

HNC

- At least 1 Higher at Grade C or equivalent
- NQ/NC qualification at Level 6
- Applications should be supported by a personal statement and a reference from PE teacher/sports coach

HND

- 2 Highers, one preferably being PE
- NQ/NC qualification at Level 6
- Applications should be supported by a personal statement and a reference from PE teacher/sports coach

HNC/D Fitness, Health & Exercise

About this course (SCQF7/8)

This course is for people with an interest in fitness training. The one year HNC will equip you with the knowledge and skills to fitness test clients, carry out gym inductions, prepare training programmes and take exercise-to-music sessions. The two year HND will help you to develop all aspects of exercise prescription, and delivery methods for health, fitness and leisure environments of all types.

What you need

- At least 1 Higher at Grade C or above although as our courses attract many applicants we prefer applicants who aspire to complete studies over 2 years at HND to have Higher English and a second Higher in a Science subject or PE
- NQ/NC qualification in a related subject at Level 6
- Applications should be supported by a personal statement and a reference from PE teacher/sports coach

HND Sports Therapy

About this course (SCQF 8)

The course helps you develop an understanding of safe and effective principles of fitness, training and injury rehabilitation. It equips you with the skills to become an effective health and sports professional and a member of a support team competent in preventing and treating injuries.

What you need

- Higher English and a second Higher in a Science subject or PE
- NQ/NC qualification in a related subject at Level 6
