

Logging on to your City Account for the first time

A **College City Account** (student login) is automatically generated when you are registered on a course. This lets you log into the college computer systems including the network and My City.

You will find your **student number** on your **Purple Smart Card**. This number is your **username** when logging into the college systems. You can find your **student number/username** under your name on your card as shown below:

Initially your **Password** will be **City** with a capital C, followed by your **date of birth** in the format: **CityDDMMYY**



For the student above the login would be:

USERNAME: 01234567

PASSWORD: City190792

You will be asked to change your password when you log-in for the first time.

Accessing WiFi (Eduroam)

Your device must support WPA2 Enterprise in order to be able to connect to eduroam.

If you are a new student, you must have logged-in to a campus PC/ thin client and updated your password before you can access eduroam.

- Select the wireless network eduroam.
- You will be prompted to enter a username and password. Enter the same username and password that you use for connecting to the College network followed by @cogc.ac.uk at the end of your username:

IDENTITY Your student number and @cogc.ac.uk
e.g. 01234567@cogc.ac.uk

PASSWORD Your College network password

iOS: If you are prompted with a QuoVadis security certificate for RIV-0M-ISE-01.cogc.ac.uk, choose 'trust'.

Android: In settings, EAP Method = PEAP, turn off 'Phase 2 authentication', set 'CA Certificate' to 'Do not validate'.
