In each block you will study approximately **5 or 6 units and academic guidance**

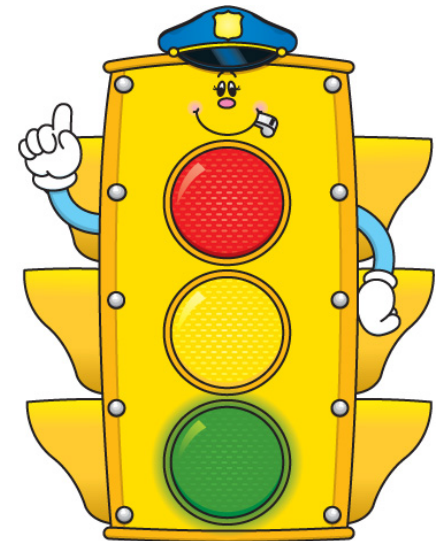

Additional selection requirements

- You must hold a valid EU passport and the right to work in the UK.
- You must be fluent in spoken and written English.
- Some airlines may also supply additional criteria.
