Local Car Parks

For people wishing to bring their car during the day, there are a number of commercial car parks close to Campus at Buchanan Galleries, Montrose Street, and at Glasgow Royal Infirmary.

For evening class students, street parking in Glasgow City Centre is free after 6.00pm while Buchanan Galleries is good value at £1.50 after 6.00pm.

Blue Badge Holders

There are a limited number of designated parking spaces for disabled drivers with blue badges; ten spaces at City Campus and four at Riverside Campus. These cannot be booked and are available on a first come, first served basis. Street parking adjacent to College buildings is also available for blue badge holders.
