Judy Kirsh: Pronunciation for Integration

Judy has more than 30 years' experience in the field of English Language Teaching as a teacher, teacher-trainer, external examiner, consultant and materials-writer. In recent years she has worked with Learning Unlimited, a social enterprise organisation based in London, on several European integration funded projects which focused on supporting migrant women to integrate into life in the UK. Judy previously worked at LLU+ London South Bank University on a wide range of projects and courses including the development of the *Citizenship materials for ESOL learners* and specialist ESOL/literacy teacher education modules and courses. Judy developed CPD modules for the British Council ESOL Nexus website and, more recently, resources for Learning and Work Institute's 'Improving Languages Improving Lives' project.
