

Inclusive Support for Students with Mobility or Accessibility issues

There are a variety of measures that we can support you with while at City of Glasgow College. These support measures will be discussed at your meeting with one of our Learning Support Advisers.

You may have had support at school or other college or university and we can continue this support for you if it is still appropriate.

The support we can offer may include:

- Personal Learning Support Plan (PLSP) designed with your support needs, interventions in place and information for curriculum lecturers to ensure your inclusion in class.
- Assistive Technology such as Texthelp Read & Write Gold or Dragon Naturally Speaking.
- Recording class lessons if appropriate.
- Writing Pens and Slopes.
- Organising Taxis and Transport.
- Reserved or Specialist Ergonomic Seating arrangements.
- Assessment Arrangements such as Extra Time, Scribe or Separate Accommodation.
- Note-taker or Practical Helper in class with you.
- Study Support with a Learning Support Lecturer.
- Ensuring rooms and spaces are accessible for you eg. Height adjustable desks.
- Lesson Breaks if required during class.
- Locker or Cupboard to store your materials.
- Personal Emergency Evacuation Plan (PEEP) arranged for you.
