



Your Pre-entry Guide to Support

Inclusive learning support for autistic students and those with other social and communication difficulties

At City of Glasgow College, we offer a range of support options to help our students succeed on their course.

Based on your individual needs, Learning Support staff can help with:

- Creating a Personal Learning Support Plan (PLSP) to support learning.
- Giving you a tour of the college campus and building before your course starts.
- Linking with your school to help you make the transition to college before your course begins.
- Providing a Learning Support staff contact to check in with regularly.
- Negotiating time-out during classes if required.
- Identifying safe spaces in the college to use if required.
- Arranging regular study skills support sessions with a Learning Support lecturer to help you develop the skills to become an independent learner. Support can include help with: coursework management; planning and structuring written work; proofreading; developing a regular college routine; and finding the most effective study strategies that work for you.
- Agreeing alternative assessment arrangements such as: adapted materials; extra time; readers; scribes; the use of ICT; or separate accommodation.
- Applying for Disabled Students' Allowance, if appropriate (Higher Education students only).
