



Your Pre-entry Guide to Support

Inclusive learning support for disabled students and those with additional support needs

At City of Glasgow College, we offer a range of support options to help our students succeed on their course.

Based on your individual needs, Learning Support staff can help with:

- Creating a Personal Learning Support Plan (PLSP) to support learning.
- Exploring Assistive Technology and equipment loan options to support learning.
- Organising ergonomic seating, or equipment.
- Providing an Educational Support Worker (ESW), or Sign Language Interpreter (SLI) in class to support your learning.
- Arranging regular study skills support sessions with a Learning Support lecturer to help you develop the skills to become an independent learner.
- Agreeing alternative assessment arrangements such as: adapted materials; extra time; readers; scribes; the use of ICT; or separate accommodation.
- Applying for Disabled Students' Allowance, if appropriate (Higher Education students only).

We offer support to students with:

- Specific learning difficulties e.g. Dyslexia, Dyspraxia or ADHD.
- Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) or other social and communication difficulties.
- Mental health Issues.
- Physical or mobility impairments.
- Health conditions or illnesses.
- Visual or hearing impairments.
- Other Additional Support Needs (ASN).
