One of the downsides of the rush to teach with technology is that many educators focused solely on technology's role in providing learners with access and flexibility, not on its facility to also increase learner engagement and improve learning outcomes. In this session, Jared Stein will explain why we should employ technology for learning that is active, not just convenient, and how deliberately blending online and onsite environments can deliver both. He'll share specific examples of how Canvas is being used further and higher education institutions around the world to transform instruction for more active and engaged learning, and give simple, practical tips on how you can do the same.
