REGISTER OF INTERESTS**

A Model Code of Conduct (Code) required by the Ethical Standards in Public Life etc. (Scotland) Act 2000 was reviewed and re-issued by Scottish Ministers in 2021. It sets out the principles and rules governing the conduct of members of devolved public bodies and City of Glasgow College (CoGC) code of conduct is based on this Code.

Board members are required to disclose and register any financial or other material interest they, close family or friends, have which might impact on their relationship with the College.

In accordance with the Model Code of Conduct for Members of Devolved Public Bodies as issued by the Scottish Government on 5 January 2022, CoGC Board of Management adopted and approved its version based on this model at its Board meeting held on 30 March 2022. In doing so, the Registration of Interests requirements and members' reporting form were adapted to comply with the Model Code.

Members must register when they are appointed and whenever their circumstances change. The register covers their current term of appointment.


