



You can find modern, well-equipped libraries at both Riverside and City campuses.

#### **OPENING TIMES**

City Campus:

Mon - Thu\* 8.30am - 9.00pm Friday 8.30am - 5.00pm

Riverside Campus:

Mon - Thu\* 8.30am - 9.00pm Friday 8.30am - 5.00pm

\*The library is self-service on these days between 7.00pm and 9.00pm.

Services within the library will cease 15 mins prior to closing time - this includes printing.

#### STUDENT CARD

Your student card is all you need to access books, ebooks, journals, DVDs and all other resources.

#### **COMPUTER ACCESS**

A range of PCs, Macs and laptops are available at both libraries. You can log into the computers and laptops using your student number and password.

#### **PRINTING & COPYING**

You can find printing and copying areas on all library floors. We offer printing and photocopying at the following prices:

#### **BORROWING**

You can borrow books for a 4 week or 1 week duration. You can renew your loans online, by telephone or by dropping into any of the libraries. You

#### **FINES**

To avoid paying fines, please make sure your loans are returned on time. Fines are charged at 10p per item per day. The maximum fine for a single item is £2.00.

## **SELF SERVICE POINTS**

When the libraries are running self-service hours, this means no members of staff are available. Self-service machines let you borrow, return and renew books yourself. You can also check the books you have on loan. These machines are available at Riverside Campus Library and on Levels 4 & 5 of City Campus Library. There are on-screen instructions showing you how to use self-service.

#### **COLLECTIONS**

We offer a range of coursespecific resources to support your studies. To find the best resources for your course, you can access our subject guides, available from the library website. You can also recommend resources you would like to see added to our collection via our website or by speaking to staff at our service points.

#### **PRINT COLLECTION**

We maintain a current collection of textbooks, journals and dvds relevant to your course. We also have a large fiction and graphic novel collection.

#### **ONLINE RESOURCES**

Our online collection of ebooks, e-journals, industry-focused databases and news archives are accessible via the library website. You can access almost all of our online resources using your student number and password, whether you are on-campus or off-campus.

#### STUDY SPACES

We offer a variety of study spaces - group study, individual study and quiet study. For quiet study, there are designated areas within each library.

#### **CUTTING AREA**

Feel free to use any of the cutting areas in the library. Here you will find staplers, a guillotine, cutting mats and other stationery at each area.

### **STATIONERY**

You can purchase competitively priced stationery essentials from our service points. We sell a range of items including pens, pencils, rulers, folders and USB sticks.

No hot or cold food in the library please. Although covered drinks are fine.

#### STUDY & RESEARCH ADVICE


If you need assistance with finding library resources, research or referencing, please speak to a member of library staff. You can also consult our library website.
