#### INTRODUCTION

Applications for Foundation Apprenticeship and Senior Phase programmes. Open on Wednesday the 13<sup>th</sup> of March 2024.

Student from Glasgow City Schools can apply directly online. Students from our areas should consult their guidance teacher or careers advisor.

Our admissions procedures aim to treat everyone who applies fairly. If you meet the entry qualifications for the course, and we have places available, we'll make you a direct offer. Details of entry qualifications and selection criteria can be found in our prospectus.

Students can choose up to 2 courses and list their choices in order of preference — we will start with the first choice when considering the application. If this is unsuccessful, or the course is full, we'll move on to your second choice. This gives everyone a better chance of securing their first-choice course.

Students will be asked to complete a simple registration process to create an account. They will require a current email address, we would prefer it **not** to be a glow address as we will need to contact applicants throughout the admissions process and this will likely include the school holidays.

Once the account has been created it can be used to


- Complete the application form.
- Track progress on your course choice(s).
- Accept or decline any offer (conditions e.g. what exams you need to pass will be in your offer).
- Enrol on the course.

# **Application Process**


To apply for a course at City of Glasgow College, please visit the College website and from the home page select 'Find a Course' and search for your course choice



Check the course overview to ensure this is the correct course for you and check the entry qualifications for the course(s) you are applying for. If you are happy to proceed select Apply Now.

You will need to register for an online account.

Please **do not use your @glow email address** as it is likely that we will need to contact you regarding your application during holiday periods.



Once you create your account, keep a note of the email address and password as you will need to access your account throughout the admissions process.



# **How to Apply**

Complete each section of the Application Overview. You can 'Save Draft' as you go along but you must Submit each section before your application can be checked and submitted.

#### 01 Course Choices

Choose up to 2 courses from the dropdown list.

Please make sure that you have read the course description carefully and that you are applying for a School College Partnership programme.



## 02 My Personal Details

Enter your name, address, postcode, and Scottish Candidate Number (please provide this as the college will contact the SQA for a copy of your pending exam results). This is a 9-digit number which can be found on your SQA Certificates.

If you do not have this number ask your school to provide it.

You will also be asked to confirm your residency details, whether you are a UK National and have lived in Scotland all your life or whether you have another residency status.






## 03 My Qualifications


Applicants whose first language is not English should have minimum ESOL Intermediate level 2 or equivalent to study on our School College Partnership courses.






#### **06 Criminal Convictions**

operated by Disclosure Scotland before they are able to participate in placement opportunities.




# **07 My Personal Statement**

Your personal statement (250-350 words) should include: -

- Why this course (or these courses) interest you;
- Why you think that you are suitable for the course(s);
- Any work placements, work experience, voluntary work or jobs, especially if it is relevant to your chosen course(s);
- What you might like to do in the future as a career after completing the course;
- Any relevant hobbies or special interests or anything that you do socially.
- Any additional information can be uploaded in Section 08 Supporting Documentation if required.
- Remember if you have made 2 choices you will need to include in your personal statement why these courses interest you. If you run out of space please upload your personal statement in Section 08






## **08 Supporting Documentation**

You will receive an acknowledgement as soon as you apply and we will advise on the progress of each application within 3-6 weeks.

Conditional **Offers must be accepted within two weeks** or they will be cancelled and the place will be offered to someone else.

One condition of the offer will be that we receive a satisfactory reference from the your school. Once conditions are met, a definite offer will be made and your place on the course will be confirmed.
